- Real progress has been made reconciling and clarifying financial records.

- Sales and rentals are almost back to pre-pandemic levels, and C-M is just about breaking even now.
- The budget now includes more money going to labor costs, a reflection of the values and goals of the organization to invest more in staff who are committed to the mission.
- There is a significant growth in grant funding. Staff have worked hard to acquire grant money for projects that reflect C-M's values.
